The New Orleans Saints are back on track The six touchdowns of Alvin Kamara in the Friday 52-33 victory against the Minnesota Vikings have drawn the longest record of the NFL, established 91 years ago by a Hall of Famer named Ernie Nevers. The day the fullback for the Chicago Cardinals set his six TD record in one match – one now shares with Kamara -- he also kicked four extra points. Nevers scored all of his team's points that day -- Thanksgiving 1929 -- in a 40-6 street against the Chicago Bears. Nevers scored all points of his team the next week, bringing his two weeks total to 59. Nevers had gained fame when he bravely led the Indians (Stanford) against Notre Dame in 1925 at the Rose Bowl", says his online entry into the Hall of Fame. "Playing on two very painful ankles, both broken at the beginning of the season, Nevers rushed for 114 yards with Stanford lost against Irish, 27-10". Fullback was his main role during the five years of professional career, but sometimes he played as a quarterback and defender and was also Chicago Eskimos' coach. He later played professional baseball and coached college football teams in the mid-1940s, with a short break to serve in the Marines during World War II. The Pro Football Hall of Fame, where it was introduced as a titular member, describes Nevers as one of the archetypical players of the early days of sport, when the attitude to everything and hardness were essential. Leather helmets were optional. A "I liked the way I played it. You did all 60 minutes," says Nevers, who died in 1976 at the age of 73. "We went from September to January and from Maine to Texas to the Pacific coast. We played 29 games and only had 16 men on the team. If the coach took a man out of the game to replace him, he was angry. Ernie Nevers: Most TDs & Points in Single Game On November 28, 1929 -- Thanksgiving Day -- The Chicago Cardinals Halfback Ernie Nevers produced one of the most memorable performances in NFL history. On a snowfield in Comiskey Park in front of about 8,000 fans, Nevers scored all 40 Cardinals points, with six quick touchdowns and four extra points, in their 40-6 win against the Chicago Bears. "This was a game we had to win," said Nevers in the book Ernie Nevers, Football Hero, "We were in a deep frustration. Previously on four games against our acerrimo rivalWe had not marked a touchdown. Someone had to do something. "Never did it sure his fast touchdown records in a game (six) and total points marked in a game (40) have never been and stand as the oldest single game record in the history of the league. Only two other players in the history of the league have ever scored six total touchdowns in a game -- Dub Jones of the Cleveland Browns in 1951 (four runs and two wins) and Gale Sayers of the Chicago Bears in 1965 (four runs, one catch and one punch return). "The final score: Bears 6, Nevers 40!" said Chicago Bears founder and then-coach GEORGE HALAS in his book Halas. "Nevers was properly deceived by the 8,000 people, including the entire Notre Dame team brought there by (Knute) Rockne for a post-season course." The previous week against the Dayton Triangles, Nevers had again scored all his team's points in a 19-0 interruption. In two consecutive games, Nevers was responsible for all 59 Cardinals points. Although the 40 points against the Bears were the highlight of his professional career, Nevers was a very talented all-round player. He was a member of the inaugural class of the Pro Football Hall of Fame in 1963, and legendary football coach Pop Warner called Nevers the greatest player he had ever coached, even superior to the great Jim Thorpe. "My proof of a great player is that he has to be able to do all things, and do just as well", Warner said. "Judged by this standard, the only man who has the right to rank with Nevers is Thorpe, the most wonderful athlete the world has ever seen. The great advantages of Corn, however, are my main reasons for putting it on Thorpe. Never had an indomitable spirit and a great love for the game."
