[6] [7] [8] Sproul personal education and life was born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, such as Robert Son of Robert Cecil Sproul, an accountant and a veteran of World War II and wife of him, Ann Mayre Sproul ( Born © and yards). [9] [10] Sproul was an avid supporter of Pirates Pittsburgh Steelers and Pittsburgh as a young man, and at the age of 15, he had to abandon up high school athletics in order to support his family. [10] He got degrees from Westminster College, Pennsylvania (BA, 1961), Pittsburgh Theological Seminary-Xenia (M.Div, 1964), the free University of Amsterdam (Dr., 1969), and the WHITEFIELD Theological Seminar (PhD, 2001). He taught numerous colleges and seminars, including the reformed theological seminar in Orlando and Jackson, Mississippi, and Knox theological Seminar at Ft. Lauderdale. [11] One of the mentors of Sproul was John Gerstner, a professor of him to the theological seminar of Pittsburgh-Xenia. The two, together with another student of Gerstner, Arthur Lindsay, co-author of the classic book Apologetics in 1984.
