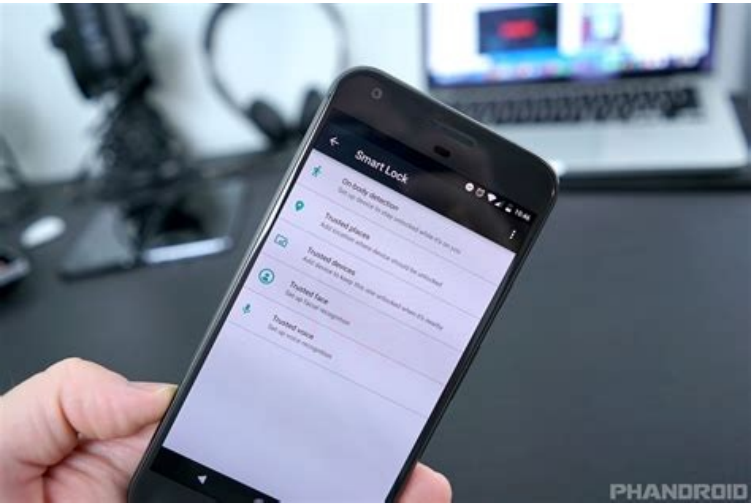

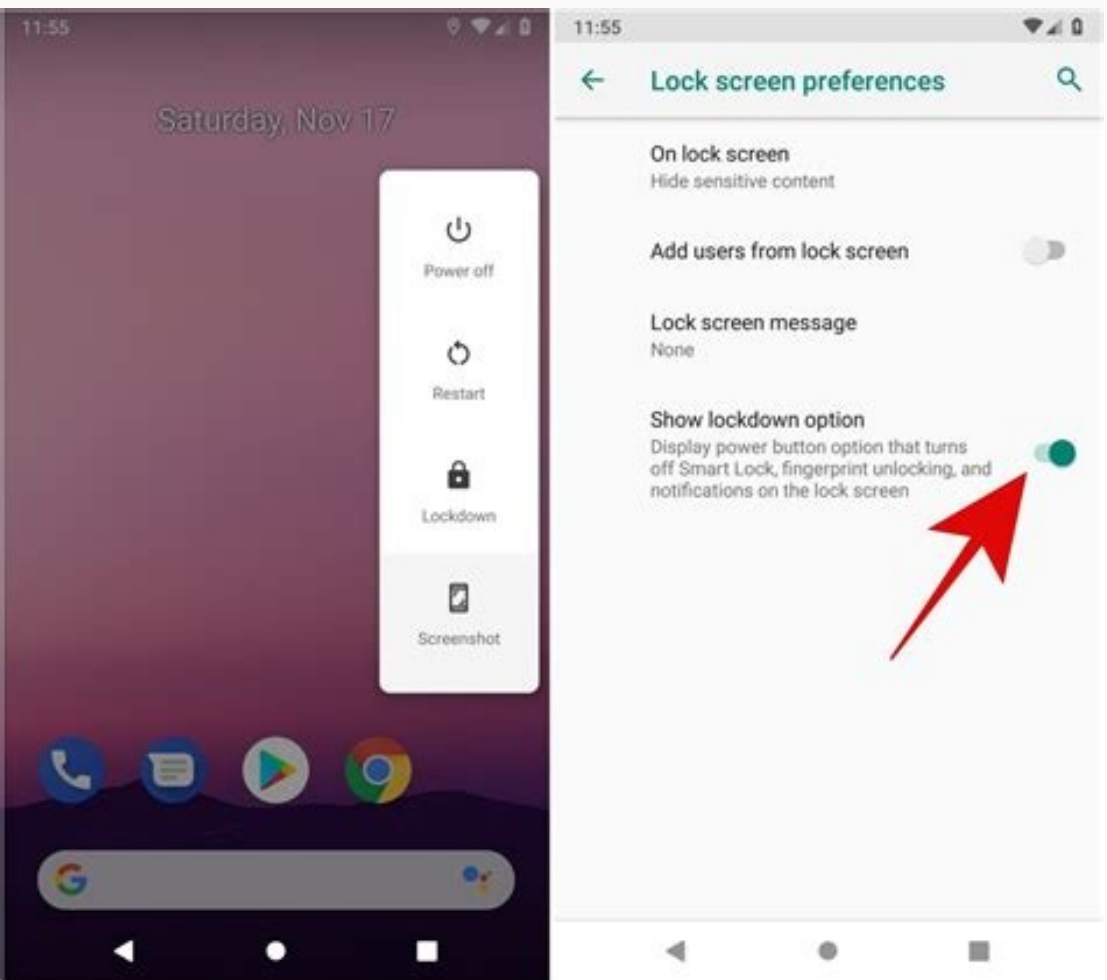

This feature is available by default on Android devices. After a few failed attempts, a message will pop up saying "Try again in 30 seconds". Below the message, click on the option which says "Forgot Pattern". Step 1. Below the message, click on the "Forgot Pattern" option. Step 2. Then, it is required to give Google account details. Step 3. Enter the primary Gmail account and password you used to set up your Android device after choosing the same. Step 4. As you sign in, an email is received to that account that allows you to set a new pattern, passcode, or draw a new pattern to lock your android phone. It is a simple feature to use, built with most Android devices. But it requires internet access to reset the pattern, which is not pragmatic every time. It's bad practice to disable the lock screen because it leaves your private information vulnerable to theft and tampering. This article explains how to turn off the screen lock on your Android phone. The exact steps may vary slightly depending upon which version of Android and which handset you own, so we'll cover the most common methods. The screen lock settings are always found in the Settings app, usually in a category that includes Security in the title. If these steps don't lead you directly to your phone's lock screen controls, a little browsing in Settings should help you find it quickly. Start the Settings app. Find the security or lock screen option. On most versions of Android, choose Security & privacy, Security, or Security & location. Find the option to set your lock screen access code. Usually, this will be Lock screen password or Screen lock. You should now be able to choose the option to disable your lock screen. Depending upon your version of the Android OS, tap Disable lock screen password or None (to specify no passcode security). You'll need to enter your current PIN or passcode to make this change and then confirm this choice in a pop-up window. Start the Settings app. Tap Lock screen. For older Galaxy devices, it's here: My Device > Personalization > Lock Screen Tap Screen lock type and enter your current passcode. Tap None. You'll need to confirm you want to do this by tapping Remove data, which will erase all biometric security data from your phone. There's no question that lock screens can sometimes be annoying or inconvenient, and disabling it means you'll never need to enter a passcode or wait for biometric security. But consider this very carefully before you do: having no lock screen exposes you to a lot of risk. If your phone is lost, misplaced, or even just out of your control briefly, anyone with physical access to your phone can open it immediately. This makes your private information extremely vulnerable, which is a particular concern since identity theft is such a concern these days. If you really don't want to enter a passcode each time you open your phone, rather than disabling your lock screen, consider turning on biometric security (like a fingerprint reader or face recognition) if your phone supports those features. Download and install the software and launch it when it is ready. Connect your phone with your computer and wait for the phone to be detected by the tool. Choose Remove Screen Lock feature from the interface. Select the first option - Remove Screen Lock for most Android devices and then click on the Start button to initiate the pattern removal process. The software will prepare the data environment and send the package to the phone. Next, 4uKey for Android will give a pop-up notifying that password removal will erase the device data. Click on the Yes button. Finally, follow the on-screen process and the software will remove the forgotten pattern lock from your Android device. As you try to unlock the Android forgot pattern with Tenorshare 4uKey for Android, you will see how easy it is. You can further restore the device data from Google backup. Pros: The process is easy and clear to follow. It is available for removing forgot pattern lock on device running Android 2 to Android 12. It also supports bypassing Samsung Google account verification after reset. Cons: It will erase data on Android devices. It currently does not work on Sony, OnePlus and Oppo devices. Removing Android forgot pattern lock without losing data is possible as long as you are using the early Samsung device. Check out the video below to learn how to unlock pattern lock without losing data. When you forgot pattern lock, there is a security feature you can rely on to unlock the forgotten pattern lock, that is, Android Device Manager or Google Find My Device. This method works for all android devices as long as you have previously logged into the Google Account on your devices, and can remotely erase the data and settings from the phone. The reset will bypass the pattern lock and help you regain access to the device. Visit the official Google Find My Device page and log in with your Google credentials. As you enter the interface, you will see the devices linked to your Google account and their location on the map. Click on the ERASE DEVICE option on the left side panel and you will be prompted to enter your password to erase the device. Again click on "Erase." This will erase the device and the Android forgot pattern lock will also be removed. Pros: The service can be used for all devices. Cons: It is useful unless Find My Device is enable on the phone. It requires internet connection and active phone. It works for Android 4.0 and above. If you prefer knowing how to unlock android phone pattern lock without Gmail ID, then you can use the Find My Mobile service with the Samsung account on your phone. But this service is only available for the Samsung device users. Visit the official website for Samsung Find My Mobile service. You will have to log in with the Samsung account to enter the interface. After you log in, you will see the Unlock option on the right side panel. Click on the option. From the pop-up window, click on "Unlock" and enter your Samsung account password to unlock it. Pros: This method is very helpful for Samsung users. It only takes a few minutes to unlock the device. Cons: This service is only available for Samsung users. The prerequisite is that you have enabled remote unlock. Some Android devices running on Android 4.4 and earlier versions comes with an inbuilt forgot pattern feature. This allows the users to simply unlock the device by using their Google ID and password. Below are the steps you need to follow to unlock Android forgot pattern lock. When you've entered the wrong passcode for 5 times, the "forgot pattern" option will appear on the screen. Tap on it. Click on it and you will be navigated to another screen to choose whether you want to use the security question or Google account to unlock the device. Choose the Enter Google account details and enter the details. You will be prompted to reset the pattern. As you finish setting up the new pattern lock, you will easily get access to your device with the new pattern. Pros: This method is quick and easy. Cons: It won't work if the device doesn't have an active internet connection. This way of unlocking Android pattern only works for phones running Android 4.4 or lower. Another method that you can try if you forgot pattern lock of Android device is to factory reset your device. This will entirely restore the device to its original condition when you bought it, but you will lose all the data stored on the device. That said, here's how to unlock forgot pattern lock on Android by performing a factory reset. When your phone is powered off, press and hold the Power and Volume Down buttons simultaneously, then press and hold the Power key until the phone enters into the Recovery mode. You can use the Volume up and down button to navigate through the option and press the Power button to select the Wipe data/factory reset option. Now select "Yes" or "Factory data reset"(depending your phone model) to perform the reset. Once the reset is finished, you can reboot your device and there will be no lock pattern on the screen. Pros: The process is very effective to remove the pattern lock. Cons: It is complicated and different for different brands. If you forgot screen lock pattern of your phone, then don't be panic and try any of the above-mentioned solutions. All of these methods proved to be effective for unlocking Android forgot pattern lock. But if you find some of the methods complicated, then Tenorshare 4uKey for Android, a great Android Pattern Lock Unlocker is always at your rescue.
